- We are pleased to advise that the Respite Rooms will be available for service from Monday 15th August. The final touches are taking place, with the new curtains being hung on Wednesday.

- **Stage 2 – Independent Living – Units.** The roofs are now on all 3 duplex units and we are almost ready for windows to be put in and cladding to be added.
- **Stage 3 – Upgrading of existing Home.** The 1st batch of wool carpet tiles were laid last week of July, in the dining room, so now the dining room is complete and looking wonderful. It was opened to the residents on Monday 1st August, with our first celebration, Jean Swindalls 100th, held in the dining room on Friday 5th.
We are the first, in New Zealand, to lay these newly developed wool tiles. The Board have been working with Wools of NZ Ltd to support, with being a rural community, the drive to promote the wool story and what a wonderful product it is.
The site works for the new Hospital wing Lounge/Dining Room has commenced. This build is to be carried out by local building contractors Corey Barnsdall and his team.
The resurfacing of the service driveway has also began, much too everybody's delight – gone are the pot holes!

The Board have received many pleasing comments regarding PROJECT HILLVIEW and its progress, the community are thrilled to see positive happenings in our district.
